



## Violin Sun Catcher

### Instructions:

1. Have an adult help you download and print this coloring sheet.
2. Using crayons or oil pastel, color in your violin. Use lots of color and fill up all the white spaces. Don't worry if you go over the edges, because we'll be cutting the violin out later.
3. Using vegetable oil, paint over all of your coloring. You can do this using either a paintbrush or a cotton swab. Vegetable oil can get messy, so ask an adult for help pouring. And be sure to cover your workspace with newspaper, before starting.
4. Let your sheet dry. This should take about an hour or two.
5. Once your sheet is dry, cut out your violin. Ask an adult for help with this if you need it.
6. Tape your finished violin in the window, or punch a hole to hang.
7. Enjoy!
